ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 [73 of 1993], and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS** the institution viz. **Debnarayan Shiksha Sansthan, Plot No-31, J.L No-97, Street.No-P.O Road, Vill-Natagachi, Po-Beniabow, Tehsil/Taluka-Sonarpur, Town/city-Sonarpur, Dist- South 24 Parganas, West Bengal-743613** was granted recognition for conduct of **B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100** from the academic session **2013-2014** vide ERC order no. **ERC/ 7-150.6.22/ NCTE/ B.Ed./ 2013/ 16580dt.02.03.2013.**

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution viz. **Debnarayan Shiksha Sansthan, Plot No-31, J.L No-97, Street.No-P.O Road, Vill-Natagachi, Po-Beniabow, Tehsil/Taluka-Sonarpur, Town/city-Sonarpur, Dist- South 24 Parganas, West Bengal-743613** has by affidavit dated **19.01.2015** consented to come under New Regulations 2014 and sought for **Two Basic Units in B.Ed. course** which require additional facilities.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have Two Basic Units of 50 students each subject to fulfilling following conditions namely,

- (i) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional fund, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committee with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii) The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC) and the Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.

- (iii) The Regional Committee shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.

5. **Now therefore**, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 15(3) (a) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grant recognition to **Debnarayan Shiksha Sansthan, Plot .No-31, J.L. No-97, Street.No-P.O. Road, Vill-Natagachi, Po-Beniabow, Tehsil/Taluka-Sonarpur, Town/city-Sonarpur, Dist- South 24 Parganas, West Bengal-743613** for conducting **B.Ed. Programme of two years** duration with an annual intake of **100** for **Two Basic Units** of 50 students each from the academic session **2015-2016** subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. If it so desires.



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- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contravenes any of the above conditions of the provisic the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there ur the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdraw recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 1 of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Debnarayan Shiksha Sansthan, Plot No.- 31, Street/Road- S T Road, Vill.- Natagachhi, P.O.- Beniabow, Tehsil/Taluka- Sonarpur, Town/City- Sonarpur, Dist.- South 24 Parganas, West Bengal- 743613 has applied for grant of permission to Debnarayan Shiksha Sansthan (B.Ed. College), Plot No.- 31, Street No.- S T Road, Vill.- Natagachhi, P.O.- Beniabow, Tehsil/Taluka- Sonarpur, Town/City- Sonarpur, Dist.- South 24 Parganas, West Bengal- 743613 (Code No. ERCAPP3399) for additional intake of B.Ed. Course online 06.06.2015 for two year duration and hard copy received by Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE on 10.07.2015.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and videography, and the certificates received from the affiliating body, the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, permission was granted to B.Ed. course with an additional intake of 50 (existing 100 intake + additional 50 intake), thus making the sum total grant of 150 intake from the academic session 2017-2018 vide order No.ER-220.6.36/ERCAPP3399/(B.Ed.-Addl. Intake)/2016/49112 dt. 30.08.2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 232nd Meeting, permission granted to the institution for B.Ed. (additional intake) of one unit from the academic session 2017-18 withdrawn vide order No.52707 dated 02.05.2017 mentioning therein that the order No.ER-220.6.36/ERCAPP3399/(B.Ed.-Addl. Intake)/2016/49112 dated 30.08.2016 treated as null and void.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE HQs. against the withdrawal order and the Appellate Authority vide order No.89-248/E-1911/2017-Appeal/11th Meeting-2017/55728 dated 24.06.2017 confirmed the impugned order dated 02.05.2017 issued by ERC Bhubaneswar.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed W.P. No. 26511 (w) of 2017 in the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta. The Hon'ble High Court disposed of the matter on 10.07.2018 with a direction inter alia:

"Mr. Chaudhuri, learned advocate appears on behalf of present affiliating university and submits, his client has already granted no objection and that might be used for the purpose of the institution getting its permission in next academic year.

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It appears from impugned order that when application was made the same was accompanied by letter dated 23rd July, 2015 issued by the then affiliating university as being a no objection certificate but the same was only on the subject of it. Subsequently, there has been change in affiliating university and present affiliating university has issued no objection as aforesaid. NCTE, Eastern Regional Committee is already in possession of the application which is now cured of the defect. The authority will consider grant of permission to the petitioner for academic year relevant to 3rd March, 2019".

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 259th meeting considered the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta and Show Cause Notice dated 23.08.2018 issued to the institution. Now, the reply dated 20.08.2018 (on the basis of proceedings uploaded on ERC website) received from the institution on 23.08.2018, was considered by ERC.

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

In addition to 100 intake already granted for B.Ed. Course uptill 2018-2019 academic session, formal permission order under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulation, 2014 for applied **B.Ed. Programme with additional intake of 50** from the session **2019-2020** be issued to the institution, thus making the sum total grant of **150 intake**.

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants permission to **Debnarayan Shisha Sansthan (B.Ed. College), Plot No.- 31, Street No.- S T Road, Vill.- Natagachhi, P.O.- Beniabow, Tehsil/Taluka- Sonarpur, Town/City- Sonarpur, Dist.- South 24 Parganas, West Bengal- 743613** for conducting **additional intake of B.Ed. Course of two years duration with an additional intake of 50 (existing 100 intake + additional 50 intake)**, thus making the sum total intake of **150 (Three basic units)** from the academic session **2019-2020** under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.



- k) Any false or incomplete information on its website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.


7. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

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8. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.

9. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition / permission by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
